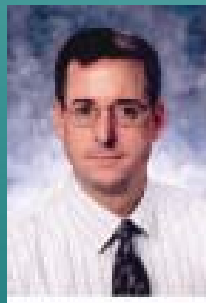
Henry is President and CEO of the National Association of State Aviation Officials. He resides in Washington D. C.
